RESIDENT CAMPER INFORMATION SUMMER 2019

Registration:

On the first day of camp (normally Sunday), you will register between 2:00pm - 3:30pm. Registration will be in the lobby of the Ice Arena. On all registration days, we will start with a player parent meeting. After the meeting, each group will have a cookout for the players, an ice session and a group activity. To see your group's daily schedule, go to the forms section of the Kent Hockey Schools web site at www.kenthockeyschools.com and find the daily schedule under the week and group you have signed up for.

Housing:

You will be housed in a dormitory located near the ice arena. You will be responsible for providing your own bed linens, blankets, pillow, towels etc... Because the dormitory is air-conditioned, it is important to bring a blanket. A sleeping bag is an alternative. We recommend that you do not bring a stereo, TV, appliance or other electronic components into the dormitory. Each room has a mini refrigerator and the floor has a microwave oven for the players to use. The Kent Hockey Schools is not responsible for lost or damaged appliances or any type of electronic components. You will also need a swim suit. A more detailed list of what to bring to camp can be found in the forms section of the Kent Hockey Schools web site.

Cell Phone Policy: We recommend that campers do not bring a cell phone. The dorm staff starting on Tuesday evening will let anyone who needs to make a call use their phone. However, if a camper does bring a cell phone it must be kept in their room at all times and they will only be allowed to use it in the evening hours.

Camp Bank:

Campers are encouraged to check spending money into the camp bank. From your bank account you can buy snacks, tape, drinks and get your skates sharpened. Also rock climbing and other activities at the Recreation and Wellness Center will be taken out of the camp bank. Campers will be informed by the middle of the week the week of their balance. Parents will receive the balance remaining in the account at the end of the week. There will be a \$4 service charge for the camp bank which will be deducted from your beginning balance.

Check out:

The camp will end upon the completion of the game on Friday morning or the last day of camp. Please refer to the daily schedule for the time of check out. Depending upon the age of the group and time of the last game the process of checking out will vary. For the older, most of the time they will bring their personal belongings to the rink in the morning and check out at the rink. For younger players, they will go back to the dorm after their game.
